ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

WITH the entry form in the TD Test of a dog, which has not passed a "Tracking Test", there must be filed a written statement by a person who is accredited by the American Kennel Club to judge a "Tracking Test", that the dog is considered by the judge to be ready for such a test. The holding of other titles including "TD" shall not bar a dog from competition in the TD test. Entries without a Tracking Degree (TD) will be accepted first.

THERE will be no actual scores for the TD or TDX Test, but the dog will be rated "Passed" or "Failed" and a TD or TDX certificate will be issued by the American Kennel Club confirming all dogs rated "Passed".

TELEGRAPH, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

ENTRY FEE is \$60.00 for the TD Test and \$100.00 for the TDX Test (includes 3.50 Recording & Event Fee) made payable to Glenbard All Breed Obedience Club, Inc. A Recording fee of 50 cents and an event fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or member club show, or obedience trial or tracking test. These fees are to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the recording fee is to be collected on the first entry only. Entry fees will be refunded within seven (7) days after completion of the Test in the event all tracks have entries or alternates have replaced entries. No entry fee will be refunded if the request is made after closing date and all tracks are not used.

ENTRIES cannot be accepted, canceled, altered or substituted after the entries close with the TD/TDX test secretary.

THE Tracking Test is limited to 4 dogs. The Tracking Dog Excellent Test is limited to 4 dogs. In accordance with the AKC Obedience Regulations (AKC Rule, Chapter 1, Section 26a) entries in this TD/TDX Test shall be accepted up until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached. A drawing will be held on Monday, April 5, 2010 at the secretary's home at 6:00 pm to determine which entries will participate in the tests. This drawing shall be completely random among all entries received except that preference shall be given to dogs, which have not earned TD or TDX titles.

SPECIAL NOTICE- At a combined TD/TDX test, if the limit for entries is not reached in one test and the limit for entries is exceeded in the other test, the number of tracks may be exchanged up to a maximum of twelve (12) TDs or six (6) TDXs. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth above, shall be similarly drawn and assigned a position on an alternate list.

The test secretary shall then notify all entries of the results of the draw. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if alternates are present and

to determine, by their position on the alternate list, which of the alternates shall participate.

The test secretary shall then notify all entries of the results of the draw. In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the Test Secretary to determine if alternates are present and to determine, by their position on the alternate list, which of the alternates shall participate.

THE assignment of dogs to the tracks, by the drawing of lots, is the responsibility of the judges.
