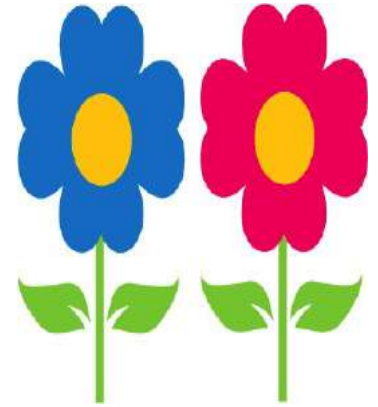

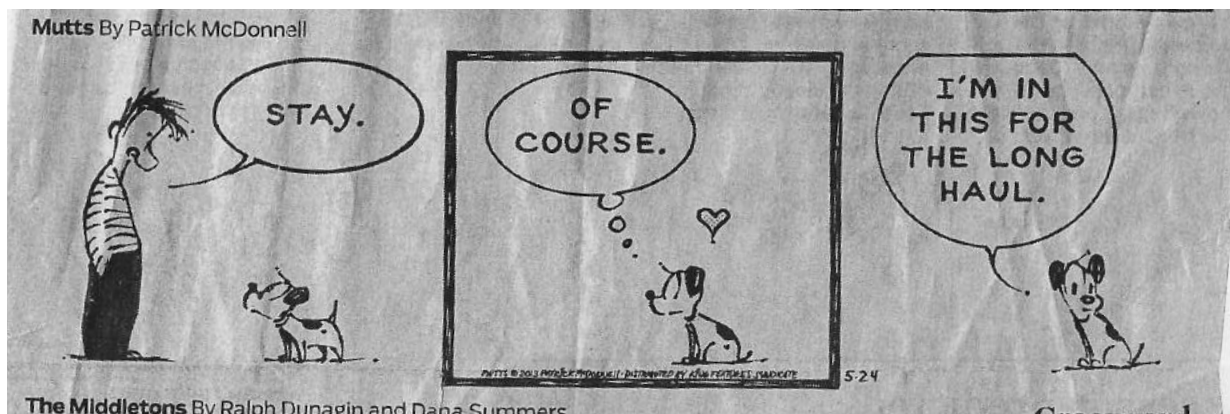

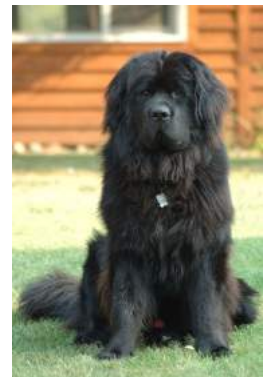

Is your dog ready to be evaluated in order to earn his **Canine Good Citizen Title**? If you are attending one of our Beginner Classes you are already working toward that goal. However, graduating from a Beginner Classes in order to be evaluated is not a requirement. If you feel your dog is ready, pre-register to be evaluated. **The maximum number of dogs to be evaluated will be 10.** Make sure you are one of the first to sign up. Sign-up forms can be found on the GABOC website (GABOC.org), in this issue of Barks, or by asking your obedience instructor. The **Canine Good Citizen Program** teaches good manners to dogs and responsible dog ownership to their owners. The 10-step CGC test is a non-competitive test for all dogs, including purebreds and mixed breeds. It is a prerequisite for many therapy dog groups and some homeowner's insurance companies encourage CGC testing. There are also an increasing number of apartments and condos that require resident dogs to pass the CGC test.

AKC Rally Tip Sheet #1 (published April 2, 2019)

AKC Rally Resources and Information

Welcome to the world of AKC Rally at GABOC! Rally work will help you and your dog develop teamwork while performing various exercises, whether you decide to just train or decide to compete. You and your dog together will navigate a course of signs where you two will perform different exercises while being judged, scored and timed. There are five class levels, from the beginning Novice class through the ultimate Master class. At all levels you may use multiple words (commands and praise, but no harsh commands and no whistling) and multiple signals to guide and encourage your dog through the course. In competition touching your dog is not allowed (with a few specific exceptions), and clapping your hands and patting your legs is allowed at the lower levels, but not allowed at the Excellent and Masters levels. Successfully completing a Rally course gives you a great sense of accomplishment, and can inspire you to continue in AKC Rally trials.

As in all sports, it is very important to know and follow the rules of AKC Rally, and then to practice both at GABOC and at home. Every course you run will be different, and there are more than 100 signs to learn and perfect if you decide to compete at the highest level. AKC provides a number of resources to assist you in this process.

The AKC website is the first place to go for information. Go to www.akc.org, and click on the tab at the top of the page called "Sports & Events," and a drop-down menu will appear. Click on the word "Rally" (under the words "Companion Sports") in the middle column. You will be at the main AKC Rally page, and a menu of topics appears on the left side of the page. This Tip Sheet will describe some of the most important topics for a beginner to learn.

Click on the topic "Exhibitor Resources" and you will see more links to important information regarding AKC Rally. Under the title of "Getting Started in Rally," look for the following:

- "Complete set of Rally signs" is a PDF document of all of the AKC Rally signs. These are the large signs that appear on the Rally course with a few words describing the exercise for each sign and one or more arrows or other pictures, but no further description of the exercise. This document can be printed if you want your own set of full-size signs to practice, but be aware, there are 115 pages in this document, and that is a lot of printing. There are other sources where you can buy these signs, as described below.
- "AKC Rally Signs and Descriptions 1-1-2018 (PDF)" is another PDF document for all of the AKC Rally signs, but the signs themselves are much smaller and are accompanied by the official AKC descriptions of the exercise to be performed at each sign. There are 15 pages in this document, so it would be easier to print. This is a handy document to have for studying as you learn the signs and exercises, and for refreshing your memory when you are at a competition. Again, there are other sources that have created handy study guides, as described below.

- You Tube Channel – AKC Obedience & Rally Videos” is a link to a You Tube page established by the AKC. The AKC produced a short video for each Rally sign to show how the principal parts of that sign could be correctly performed, and for some signs there are two or more videos to show how that sign could be correctly performed. The AKC posted these videos “for purposes of illustration only,” and watching the videos can be very helpful to all Rally exhibitors. If you click on the word “Playlists” on the main page, you will see a Playlist for the signs for each class level.

Under the title “Regulations And Forms” is a link to “Rally Regulations.” This is a 100-page PDF document containing the specific rules for the sport of AKC Rally. It is very helpful for an exhibitor to have a copy of this document, both in printed form and on their electronic device. The Rally Regulations can be printed from the website by anyone, or a printed copy can be ordered from the AKC. There are other separate regulations that also apply to AKC Rally, and those are the “Obedience Regulations” and the “Rules Applying to Dog Shows.” It is best to start with the Rally Regulations, and catch up with the others later. Be aware that the AKC will make changes to the Rally Regulations from time to time, and exhibitors need to keep up-to-date with those changes.

Under the title “Newsletters” is a link to “Judges.” which is a link to an electronic newsletter addressed to AKC Rally and Obedience judges about changes in rules and/or procedures in those sports. Anyone can follow this newsletter to stay up-to-date with such changes by entering their email address in the box on the right-hand side of the page. Another way to keep up with changes is to go to the main AKC Rally page and click on “News and Updates.”

There are a number of companies that sell Rally-related products, including signs and handy study guides. A few of them are:

There is also Amazon, and you can also search the Internet. GABOC does not promote or endorse any of these companies; this list is provided to you for convenience purposes only.

Two companies have developed an app for mobile devices. One app is called “K9Rally.” and the other app is called “Pocket Rally” (search for “Blue Ribbon Pocket Rally,” otherwise you will only find apps about auto rally races). Both apps include all Rally signs and descriptions, other information from the AKC Rally website, and links to the AKC Rally videos. It can be very handy to have these apps when you are at a trial and you want to refresh your memory about how to perform a sign. Again, GABOC does not promote or endorse these apps; this information is provided to you for convenience purposes only.

GABOC offers AKC Rally run-throughs on most Mondays at 2:00 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. GABOC also offers different levels of obedience classes on most Monday evenings as listed on the GABOC website (www.gaboc.org), and joining obedience classes might help your performance at Rally trials. These events are held at the DuPage County Fairgrounds in Wheaton, Illinois. Please see the website for further information about the schedule and classes. GABOC would love to have you join these events!

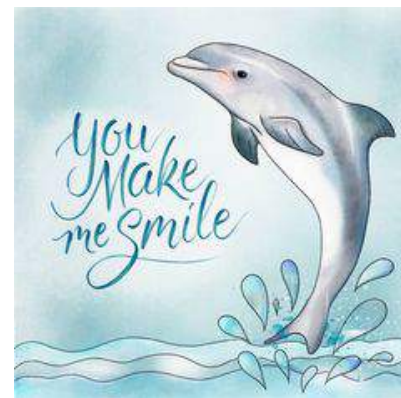

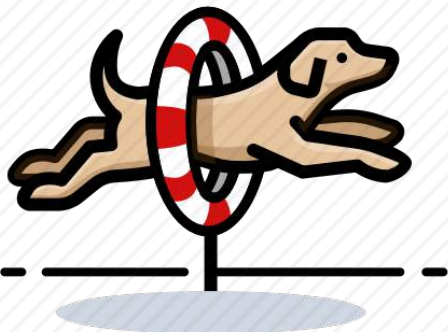

B.A.R.K. Program to Get Kids Excited About Reading
