



Enjoy the show, trials, network, and LEARN!





- The Samoyed's white, cream, or biscuit coat consists of a dense, wooly undercoat and long, silver-tipped guard hairs. The thick undercoat can be carded, spun, and knit into cozy sweaters.
- Queen Alexandra of the United Kingdom became an enthusiastic fan of Samoyeds when she was gifted a dog from the Czar of Russia.
- Aika, a one-year-old Samoyed, escaped from her home on the Arctic coast in June 2021 and wandered the ice fields for more than a week before being rescued by a Russian icebreaker.
- According to DNA analysis of the canine genome, Samoyeds are one of 14 breeds identified as "ancient," and closely related to wolves.
- A Samoyed who lived in California during the 1950s, Rex of White Way, was involved in more than 30 human rescues and served as a lead sled dog in the mail run that scaled the 7,200-foot Targhee pass on the border between Idaho and Montana.
