

Cold Weather Safety Tips for Dogs, from Head to Ears, Nose and Paws!

Ears, Nose and Tip of the Tail

Extreme temperatures can result in frostbite, and for dogs, the paws, nose, ears and the tip of tall can be especially vulnerable. If you suspect your dog may have frostbite, visit your veterinarian immediately. En route, handle the affected areas with extreme care, and wrap the pet in warm towels or blankets.

Torso

Some dogs (like Lucy the Chihuahua mix) need help keeping their bodies warm. If your dog has a short coat like Lucy's, invest in a well-fitted sweater or coat for trips outdoors. But if your dog is built for the winter weather (Huskies, St. Bernards, etc.), a sweater may cause him to overheat, so let him enjoy the outdoors au nature!



It's important to keep your dog's mind and body active, even when she's stuck indoors. Make time for regular games of indoor fetch, or teach her a new trick, like roll-over or shake. Kongs and puzzle toys are also a great way to engage the mind and make them work hard for those treats!

Paws

Salt, sand, snow, ice, and de-icing chemicals can cause dry paws, cracking, irritation, injury, and even infection. Put on dog booties or paw wax before going outside and wipe your dog's paws clean after every outdoor trip.






