Member Highlight~

Jan Jakubiak



Growing up in a family with no dogs and wanting one so badly, in elementary school I read every book about them and memorized all the breed names, groups they belonged, and anything about obedience training. Still it took 25 years to get my first dog, a female German Shepherd Dog (GSD). German Shepherds were an important part of life on my Grandmother's dairy farm so it was decided this was a good breed to begin my obedience journey. But actually owning/training a GSD and reading about it were two different things! Fortunately, she was very intelligent, friendly and tolerant of beginner mistakes, earning a Novice Obedience title in 1977. She was the first of four GSD I trained and loved.

In 2013 an instructor at a soon-closing obedience school I was attending, suggested a visit to Glenbard All Breed Obedience Club where she also instructed on Mondays. What good advice it turned out to be because on the first night of Novice II class several GABOC members warmly introduced themselves. Years had passed between training my GSDs, so relearning skills long forgotten became a mission with the new fourth GSD, Tessa. Like a kid in a candy shop, I wanted to sample other participation activities too, and Rally, Agility and Nosework became exciting new things to try.

Last March 2017 I crossed off my “bucket list” something I'd wanted to do since reading about it in childhood: visiting England's 126th annual Crufts, the Largest Dog Show in the World with 24,000 dogs attending. A dream come true. After returning from seeing dogs from all over the world competing in so many venues, I was motivated to train harder, and with help from supportive GABOC friends and instructors I can accomplish that. This is the best life anyone could have being with my dog and around others who love theirs!

If you would prefer a quick exam and one of the GEAH doctors to call to discuss the blood results that option is available. The cost for the exam is \$35.00

PS-There has been a HUGE increase for the Rabies tag for intact dogs in DuPage County!

SECRETARY'S REPORT

2. Donna reported the membership update for February:

91 renewed memberships this year: 22 life members, 23 family members, 46 single members

Net 9 fewer memberships from 2017 end-of-year. Reasons: Only in area part of the year. Did not come to training last year. Health issues. Moved out of state. No reason--but have done this before. No dog. Change in lifestyle. Always renew late. Passed away.

Dawn Parison requested reinstatement via a written letter addressed to the Board of Directors: This request followed the process as described in the Bylaws, Article 2, Section 4e. The Board of Directors voted and approved Dawn Parison's reinstatement request.

TREASURER'S REPORT

1. Donna Eichman reported that our physical year runs from December to November.

2. We ended the year \$1,880.73 in the black.

3. Our insurance went down \$214.80.

4. Rent went up \$8.33 per night. We are actually paying the same amount as last year, however, we will train one less Monday in 2018.

5. Our total rent for the year is \$19,600. We pay 1/4 of that amount each quarter. March 1 will be the first-quarter payment.

6. The 2018 Trial will be held at the Fairgrounds. A deposit of \$1,200 has already been paid.

7. January's Agility Trial netted a profit of \$3,393.15

DIRECTOR OF TRAINING

1. Jim Clarke reminded instructors that they should finish their classes on time so the next class can begin on time.

2. Jim pointed out that when Maryt does not instruct Rally at Early Training, we are using the signs that are in the bottom of the bin and are antiquated. Maryt brings and uses her own signs when she sets up for Rally at Early Training and at the evening Rally.

A motion was made by Lisa Foltz and seconded by Bob Melka that a new set of Rally signs be purchased at a cost of approximately \$212.00. Motion carried.

REGISTRAR

1. Karen Heitz reported that everything is going great. Out of curiosity, Karen asks people who are signing up for classes how they heard of GABOC. She has been told that they are referred by vets, breeders, and trainers.
2. Donna Darland says she loves her class roster. Has great information on her students.

MATCHES

1. Cheri Nicholas said the first match will be Tuesday, March 6. The sign-up sheet will be on the table Monday.

AWARDS

1. Jim Clarke reminded everyone to sign up for the Awards Banquet. This year he will be presenting: 6 large plaques, 6 small plaques, 52 title plates, and 3 people will be inducted in the Hall of Fame.

WELLNESS CLINIC

1. Donna Eichman reported that we will once again hold our Wellness Clinic the entire month of March. When people make the appointment with the Glen Ellyn Clinic, they need to mention that they are with GABOC. For an additional cost of \$35, you can get an exam along with the results of the blood work.

WEBSITE

1. Jim thanked Bob and Lee Melka for the time and effort they have put in compiling the collection of pictures that will appear in the 2017 Awards Winner Booklet that will be distributed at the banquet, for the pictures that appear in BARKS each month, and for updating the Hall of Fame section on the website.

BARKS

1. Cheri Nicholas shared her concern that the Brags section of BARKS is being used for political purposes. Cheri recommended that a disclaimer be added to BARKS.
2. It was the consensus of the membership present at the meeting that BARKS should be printed with no additional comments in the Brags section.



3. The disclaimer will read, "Submissions may be edited to include only facts relating to the achievement." That means that Brags will be printed without "political" comments. That also means Cheri will have the right to edit. The disclaimer will clearly indicate that editing will happen.
