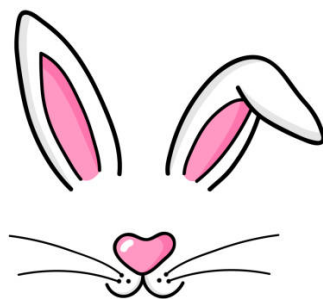

Glenbard Membership Meeting February 7, 2024 at Denny's

Meeting called to order 7:07 PM

In attendance: Pat Senne, Joan Mazat, Sandi Stephenson, Tyler Dundek, Gina Hoener, Ed Gegenheimer, Karen Schlipf, Isabel Lopez, Cathy Labash, Candy Ellis and Carole Moen.

Zoom attendance: Bette McMillan, Kathy Bianchetti and Carol Schmidt.

Vice President Report: We have 66 members of which 22 are lifetime. Kathy wanted to know what the requirements were for lifetime. Carole said 20 years being a member with which would include 10 years of service. Examples of service were given.

New member applicant: Megan Meyers from Elk Grove with Lucy a Poodle mix. Approved.

Also Pam Wirsing from the German Shepherd club who has an older Shepherd and has volunteered to substitute teach was approved by the board at their last meeting along with Sherry DeCarlo who has Cooper, (Italian for dog).

Treasurers Report: Joan went over the profit and loss report that Shawn printed out.

It was asked if the members brought food to the trial for the workers and judges. Long ago we did, but not anymore, especially since Covid.

Presidents Report: We were told for the next three weeks we would only have building two. Joan brought up the need for applying for a 501c(3). It would be nice to have our own permanent home. We would be eligible for tax free situations. Donations made to the club would be write offs for the donating entity. We could also apply for grants. Joan reminded us that Isabel has written grants. Karen made a motion to proceed looking into getting non-profit status. Sandi seconded. Unanimous. Joan said Shawn will get a dollar amount from our accountant that we used a few years back for our taxes. The accountant felt the club would be able to qualify for non-profit status.

Bylaws update: Gina heard back from AKC. They accepted all our revisions except voting in new members. It still had to be done by 2/3 of the membership.

Gina also had other wording that AKC said we needed to add to some parts. We were surprised to know our area is greater Lombard. Of the 14 members attending the meeting the vote was unanimous to accept the bylaw revisions.

Registrars Report: Pat stated the classes were going good.

She also mentioned the Canine Ambassador program that AKC sent her information on. It was about going to schools, libraries and other places to speak about responsible dog ownership. Carole asked if we were supposed to take a dog along. It was unclear. A Red Rover seminar that Carole had taken several years ago did not want you to take a pet along. Ed suggested putting it in Barks.

Pat also told us about the Raise the Woof gala. It is to help raise funds for the new extension building for the DuPage Animal shelter. One of Sheila's conformation students, Joan Barry is involved with the fund raiser and asked the club if Glenbard could make a donation for the gala. Joan said the shelter does not get government money. The membership unanimously voted to offer 5 training gift certificates. The gala is April 12th. Tickets are \$250 a person.

Gina asked for Kelsey if the website could be made more cell phone user friendly. She was told someone needed to speak to Laura S about that.

Gina said she would like some permanent signs made up for the fun matches. Some signage in the building for coming events would be nice too. The only problem will be having to put it out every training night and take it down.

A binder was suggested for drop-in training with some sort of hold harmless waiver included.

Agility trial: Bette reported the Britney club had give up the Friday date. June and October trials were at the Farm.

The calendar needs to stay updated on the website. An events page in Barks was suggested.

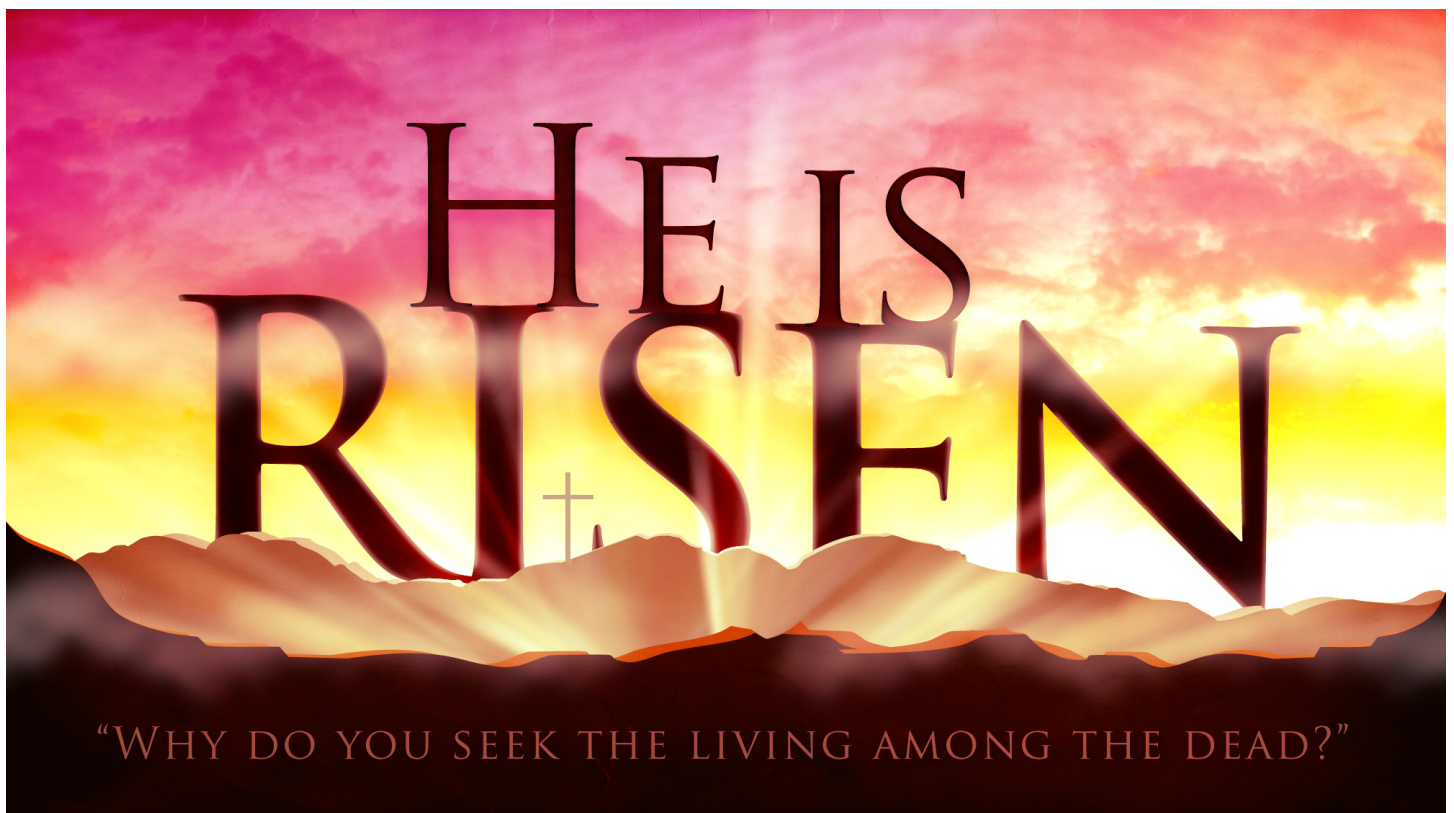
Secretary Report: The minutes from the November meeting as published in Barks and sent via constant contact were approved.

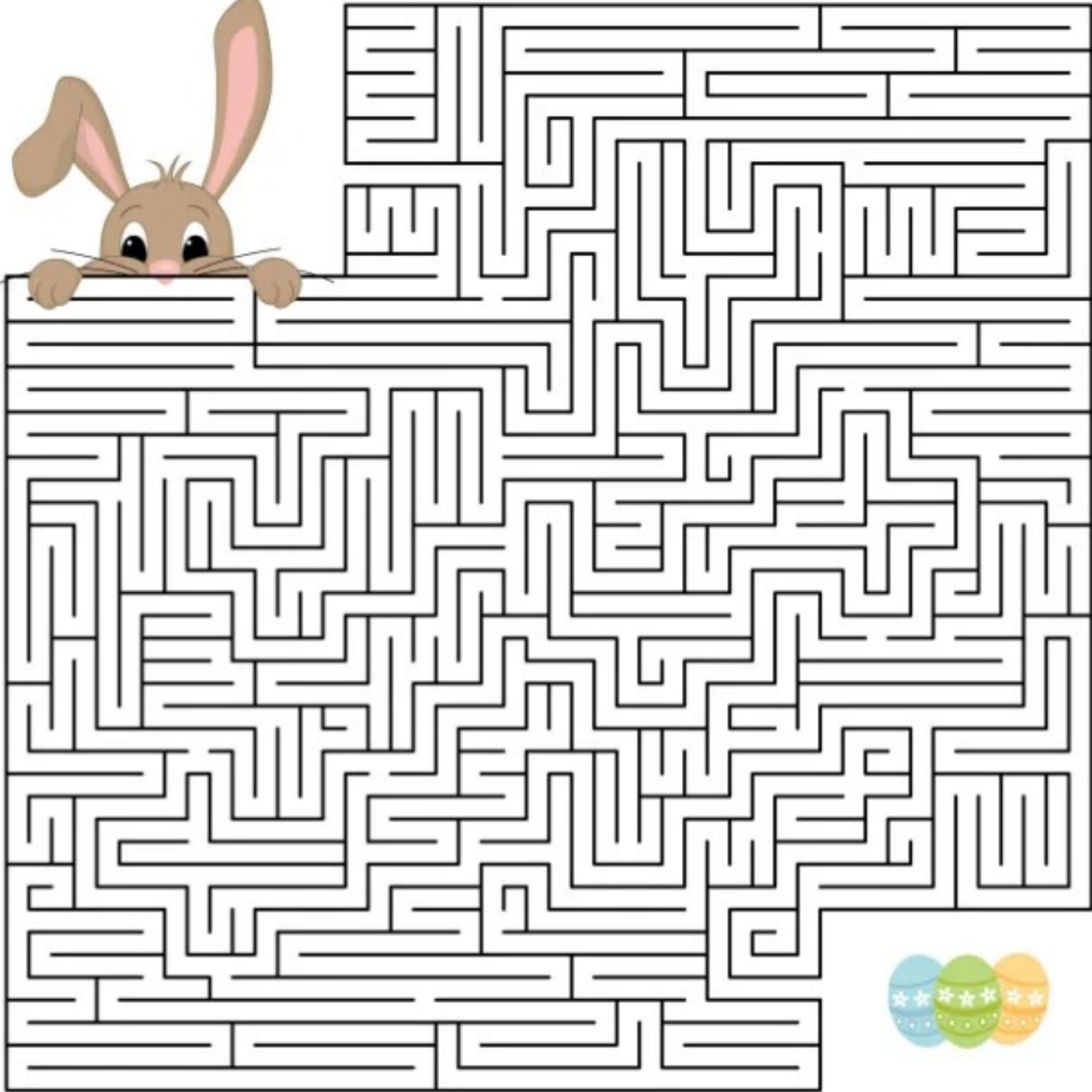
Carole mentioned the break-away jumps that AKC was requiring the clubs to use by July 1st of 2025. Joan mentioned a petition that was circulating objecting to them.

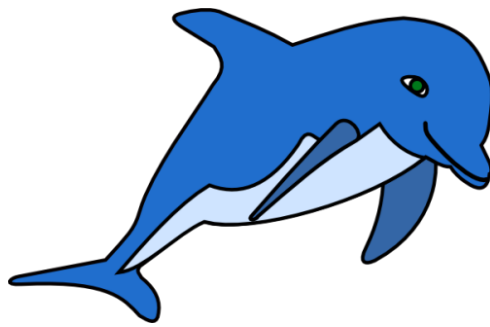

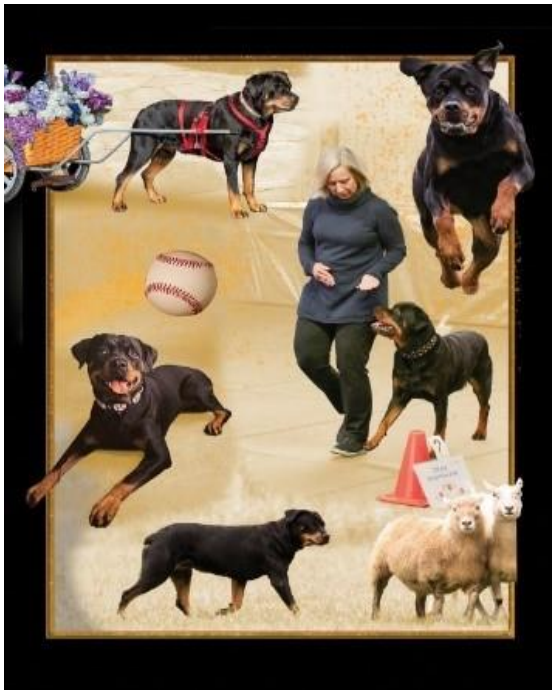
